

JESUS CHRIST DECLARED WITH POWER TO BE THE SON OF GOD BY THE RESURRECTION FROM THE DEAD *ROMANS 1:4*

You that have kept the fast, and you that have not, rejoice today for the Table is richly laden!

> Let no one grieve at his poverty, for the universal kingdom has been revealed.

Let no one mourn that he has fallen again and again; for forgiveness has risen from the grave.

Let no one fear death, for the Death of our Savior has set us free.

"O death, where is thy sting? O Hell, where is thy victory? "Christ is Risen, and you, o death, are annihilated!

Christ is Risen, and the evil ones are cast down!

Christ is Risen, and the angels rejoice!

Christ is Risen, and life is liberated!

Christ is Risen, and the tomb is emptied of its dead; for Christ having risen from the dead, is become the first-fruits of those who have fallen asleep.

To Him be Glory and Power forever and ever. Amen!"




